Rural transport

The vehicles used in villages are called rural transport.

The vehicles are slow.

Less number of people can be carried at a time.

Eg. Bullock-cart, tractor,
Bicycle etc.

Urban transport

The vehicles used in cities and towns are called urban transport.

The vehicles are fast.

More number of people can be carried at a time.

Eg. Car, bus, train,
aeroplane etc.

Ans: The four types of Indian roads are-

- a. National highways – they connect one state to another state of our country.

- b. State highways - they connect the various regions within the state.
- c. District Roads – they connect one district to another district.
- d. Village roads – they connect one village to another and also to districts.

Ans : A network of rivers, streams, lagoons that have boats and steamers to transport people and goods is called inland water transport.
