I. Answer the following questions


1.Name the calendar which is internationally the most popular civil calendar.

Ans. Every fourth year when February has 29 days instead of 28 is called a leap year. A leap year has 366 days. The year 2020 was a leap year.

3.Distinguish between AD and BC. Draw a timeline and mark AD(CE) and BC(BCE) on it. **Ans.** The letters A.D. stand for 'Anno Domini' which means 'the year of the Lord' and the letters B.C. stand for 'Before Christ'.

5.How will you find a leap year in a Saka Calendar?

Ans. *Chaitra* is the first month of the Saka Calendar and it has 30 days. Normally *Chaitra* starts on March 22, but, in the leap year it has 31 days and starts on March 21. Thus, a leap year has 366 days in Saka Calendar.
