Ans: The Select tool or Selection tool is used to select any part of the picture that we want to change. There are two selection tools available in MS Paint which are Rectangular selection tool and Free-Form selection tool.

Rectangular selection tool: - This tool is used to select any object in a rectangular form.

**Q.2) What are the two ways to flip a picture? Explain any one. (Page No.66, Q.No. F/2)**

Ans: Flip means to rotate or turn the picture. To flip a picture, follow these steps:

- i) Click on the Select tool and select the picture.
- ii) Select the Rotate option in the Image group on the home tab.
- iii) Select the desired option to flip or rotate the picture.

**Q.3) How will you create a callout shape in Paint? (Page No.66, Q.No. F/3)**

Ans: Steps to create a callout shape in Paint are:

- i) Click on any of the Callout shapes from the Shapes group.
- ii) Click and drag the mouse pointer on the Drawing Area to draw the desired callout.
