

Things To Remember


- The figure formed by two rays with the same initial point is called an angle. The common initial point is called the vertex of the angle & the rays forming the angle are called its sides or arms.
- $\, \blacksquare \,$ The standard unit for measuring an angle is degree , denoted by $^\circ$
- The instrument used for measuring angles is called a protractor.



Q2. Name all the possible angles in the adjoining figure;




Q3. Name the angles shown , using capital letters;
