Answer the following questions: Q1. What is light?

Ans. Light is a kind of energy that causes the sensation of sight.

Q2. What are luminous and non luminous objects? give examples.

Ans. The objects that give their own light are called luminous objects.e.g the sun, candle, lamp, bulb etc. the objects that do not give their own light are called non luminous objects.e.g chair, pen, wall, paper etc.

Q3.What are transparent materials, translucent materials and opaque materials. Give two examples of each.

Ans. Transparent materials: the material which allows the light to pass through it is called transparent

materials.eg clean air and glass.
Translucent materials: the material which allows the light to pass through it partially is called translucent material.e.g ground glass and butter paper.

Opaque material: the material which does not allow the light to pass through it is called opaque material.e.g metal sheet and cardboard.
