A. Answer the following questions: -

Q1) What are producers ?

Ans) Green plants that prepare their own food by the process of photosynthesis are called producers.

Q2) What are consumers ?

Ans) Animals that consume the food prepared by the plants are called consumers .

Q3) Explain the difference between herbivores , carnivores and omnivores .

Ans) Herbivores are animals that eat only plants and plant products . e.g.-
dear ,rabbit etc.

Carnivores are animals which eat the flesh of other animals . e.g. lion , tiger etc.

Omnivores are animals that eat both plants and flesh of animals . e.g. crow , bear etc.

Q4) What are scavengers ? Gi've two examples.

Ans) Some animals feed on dead plants and animals . These animals are called scavengers . e.g. hyena, vulture etc.

Q5) What are decomposers?

Ans) Microorganisms like bacteria and fungi feed on dead remains of plants and animals are called decomposers.
