A. Answer the following questions: -

Q1) What are producers?

Ans) Green plants that prepare their own food by the process of photosynthesis are called producers.

Q2) What are consumers?

Ans) Animals that consume the food prepared by the plants are called consumers.

Q3) Explain the difference between herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.

Ans) Herbivores are animals that eat only plants and plant products . e.g.-dear ,rabbit etc.

Carnivores are animals which eat the flesh of other animals . e.g. lion , tiger etc. Omnivores are animals that eat both plants and flesh of animals . e.g. crow , bear etc.

Q4) What are scavengers? Gi've two examples.

Ans) Some animals feed on dead plants and animals. These animals are called scavengers. e.g. hyena, vulture etc.

Q5) What are decomposers?

Ans) Microorganisms like bacteria and fungi feed on dead remains of plants and animals are called decomposers.
