9. Describe the structure of a seed briefly.

Ans- A seed has following parts-

- Seed Coat- The outer covering of the seed is called the seed coat.
- Seedling- There is a tiny plant inside a seed which is called a seedling.
- Seed leaf or cotyledon- A seed has seed leaf or cotyledon inside them.
