SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

A **sentence** is made up of two parts subject and predicate.

Subject – The subject is the person or thing being talked about in a sentence.

Predicate – The predicate is the remaining part of the sentence that tells more about the subject.

Predicate has the verb.
