#### Lifecycle of a butterfly-

A butterfly has 4 stages in its lifecycle. They are as following:-

- Egg- The female butterfly lays eggs on plant leaves.
- Larva- Each egg hatches to produce larva that looks like a worm called caterpillar.
- Pupa- A caterpillar eats leaves to grow quickly. After sometime it sheds its skin to form pupa.
- Adult- the caterpillar changes its shape slowly inside the pupa as a result it bursts to come out as a butterfly.
