Q11) Differentiate between solute and solvent.

Ans) The substance which dissolves in a liquid is called the solute whereas the liquid in which a solid gets dissolved is called the solvent.

Q12) What is the difference between sedimentation and decantation?

Ans) The process of settling down of insoluble substances at the bottom of the container leaving clear liquid on top is called sedimentation whereas the process of removing the clear liquid after settling down of sediment is called decantation.

Q13) What is filtration?

Ans) The process of separation of insoluble substances from their solution by passing the solution through a filter paper is called filtration.
