Do the following questions in your Geography copy :

1. Give a short note on grid.

Ans : A grid is a set of horizontal lines (parallels of latitudes) and vertical lines (meridians of longitudes). It is used to find out the exact location of

a

place on a map.

2. Differentiate between Physical and Political Map.

Ans :

<u>Physical Map</u>	<u>Political Map</u>
These maps reveal the <u>physical aspects</u> of the earth on a flat surface.	Maps which show <u>political divisions</u> of the earth are called political maps.
They show mountains, rivers, valleys, plains, plateaus, etc.	They show countries, states, districts, etc.
In physical maps, <u>different colours are used</u> to show different landforms of the earth. Physical maps are <u>small scale maps</u> .	Different types of <u>political boundaries are used</u> to demarcate the countries, states, districts, etc. Capital cities are marked with a black round dot.
