Q1.What is the difference between shrubs and herbs?

Ans)Shrubs -Shrubs are small plants with many thin,brown,woody stems.Their branches grow close to the ground.For example-

rose,cotton,tomato,jasmine and hibiscus are some examples of shrubs.

Herbs-Herbs are small plants with soft green stems.They usually grow to three to four months. That is why they they are known as seasonal plants.For example- grass,spinach,mint,coriander and tulsi.

Q2.Write the functions of roots and stems.

Ans)Roots fix the plant to the soil.They take water and nutrients up from the soil.

Stems provide support to the plant.They take food and water to all the parts of a plant.
