Ans: The two physical properties of water are:

- Water does not have any definite shape.

Ans: The three forms of water are:

- solid as ice,
- liquid as water and
- gas as steam or water vapour.

8. Define the following terms:

Ans:

(a) Evaporation - The process of changing a liquid into a gas is called evaporation.

- (b) Condensation - The process of changing a gas into a liquid on cooling is called condensation.
- (c) Solidification - The process of changing a liquid into a solid on cooling is called solidification.
- (d) Melting - The process of changing a solid into a liquid on heating is called melting.
